







### 2. Things to bring with you:

#### Towels !!!

Anything you need to make sound and documentation for your own work and is that mobile (like your smart phone!)

And (primarily for the musicians) please bring any of these items below if you need them:

- 1. Mallets
- 2. Bows (for cellos)
- 3. Microphones (singers and others) and/or field recording devices (ZOOM or other type of digital recorder beside your smart phone)
- 4. Any cables/chords connecting your recording device to other devices.
- 5. Sound cards
- 6. Laptops and all cables required for output to a mixer.
- 7. Cameras (photo, video)
- 8. Small percussion instruments or sound making objects

**CURRENCY:** If you plan to use cash, you should change your money before arriving to **Lithuanian litas.** 

#### **INSURANCE:**

You must have valid and appropriate health/medical insurance when you arrive. Please check to make sure you have coverage (either as an EU citizen or otherwise).

The Lithuanian Academy of Music and Theatre, the Art Printing House, the Fabrika Hostel, and the N+ ECA Network are NOT responsible for any of the participants' damaged or stolen property or instruments. Musicians please arrange insurance for your instruments.

# **ARRIVING TO VILNIUS AUGUST 20<sup>TH</sup>:**

YOU MUST ARRIVE NO LATER THAN 16:00 AUGUST  $20^{\mathrm{TH}}$  TO THE YOUTH HOSTEL (SEE BELOW) IN VILNIUS .

AT 17:15 students from the Lithuanian Academy of Music and Theatre / LMTA will meet all incoming international students at the Fabrika Hostel (see Fabrika Hostel information below) and walk them over to the Art Printing House, so as to begin the 18:00 Information / Meet and Greet session. This will be followed by a light dinner sponsored by the LMTA and the NORDPLUS / N+ ECA Network.

If you arrive by plane, you can take a taxi from the airport to the Fabrika Hostel

The taxi will cost approximately 20 litas =  $6.20 \in$

# ACCOMMODATION/BOARD

All incoming international students will be housed at:

You may check in as early as 14:00 on August 20<sup>th</sup>. However if you arrive earlier, you may leave your belongings in their luggage room, and even it might be that the rooms are free earlier than 14:00, but they cannot guarantee this.

The cost will be  $9 \in$  a night = 12 nights =  $108 \in$  or 373 Lithuanian litas. You must pay this total amount with your credit card or cash (Lithuanian litas only, NO other cash currency accepted) upon arrival on August  $20^{th}$ . Make sure if you have some kind of "electronic" VISA or Mastercard that it will function in Lithuania. The Youth Hostel will accept Visa Electron credit cards.

They will provide, blankets, pillows, sheets. YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN TOWELS.

You can prepare food at the Youth Hostel in their kitchen (and store food in their fridge)...but please remember patience and flexibility as there will be many persons, especially in the mornings trying to prepare their own food. There are food stores where you can purchase food within a short walking distance from the Youth Hostel.

There are small lockers in each room for valuables. You can get one of the 8 padlocks for these lockers from the hostel and they take 10 litas deposit for the padlock which they return to you at the end of the stay when you return the padlock.

You may also bring your own padlock.

For any larger items, you may leave such items in their luggage room. However they are not responsible for loss or damage of these items.
